



Mary Mellon was a cook in New York with a chronic infection, who refused and skirted treatment, resulting in a typhoid outbreak in 1907. Twenty years later my father was a young Boy Scout on a field trip. The troop leader identified a running brook and directed two members to get fresh water for the camp. They found a closer stagnant source, so they quickly obtained that water and returned to their games. The truth of their laziness and deception became evident as an outbreak of typhoid fever spread through the troop. Many were hospitalized and several of the unsuspecting boys died. My father first rehearsed elements of his encounter with typhoid to me when I was seven years old. We had moved into a house with a small creek running through the back yard and he wanted to make sure we didn't drink from the creek, as well as give an example of the consequences of disobedience, carelessness, and selfishness. While he didn't go into details about the deaths, he emphasized how sick he and others became because two boys chose their own goals over the

Our country is facing a real and growing crisis at the Southern Border. (*NFRW MAGA Action Alert January 9, 2019*)

Every day, 2,000 inadmissible migrants arrive at our border and overwhelm our immigration system.

We do not have the resources to hold them, and legal loopholes and activist court rulings prevent authorities from properly returning them.

Immigration courts have a backlog of over 800,000 cases.

Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) has arrested 266,000 aliens with criminal records in the last two years.

There has been a dramatic spike in deadly drugs flowing across our border.

300 Americans die every week from heroin, 90 percent of which comes across our Southern Border.

Customs and Border Protection seized or help seize 1.7 million pounds of narcotics last year.

There was a 73 percent increase in fentanyl crossing the border last year.

We face a humanitarian crisis as human smugglers exploit vulnerable migrants and profit off our broken immigration system.

1 in 3 migrant women are sexually assaulted on the dangerous trek to the border.

20,000 migrant children were illegally smuggled into the country last month alone. These children are used as human pawns by vicious coyotes and ruthless gangs.

President Trump has presented Congress with a comprehensive, detailed proposal to provide the resources needed to secure the border and stop the criminal gangs, drug smugglers, and human traffickers.

The Administration has requested \$5.7 billion for construction of approximately 234 miles of new steel barrier on the Southern Border, a \$4.1 billion increase over the bill passed by the Senate Appropriations Committee.

Ten years ago, 79 Senators - including Senator Schumer - voted for just such a steel barrier.

To protect our communities, the Administration requested \$675 million to deter and detect narcotics, weapons, and other materials crossing our borders.

Among the Administration's requests for more resources are:

\$211 million to hire 750 additional Border Patrol agents;

\$571 million for 2,000 additional ICE personnel;

\$4.2 billion for 52,000 detention beds, personnel, transportation, and detention alternatives; and

\$563 million for 75 additional immigration judges and support staff.

Now Is the Time for Congress to Act

Congress has a responsibility to protect the safety and security of the American people and it needs to meet that responsibility by providing the funding needed to secure the border.

Congress needs to hear from the American people. Call or write to your Congressman and Senators as soon as possible - today if you can. Calls to all Members help build support and momentum.

Judicial Surge as Trump Looks to Restore Constitution to the Courts



Few presidents know better than Donald Trump how the courts – eaten up by liberal activist judges – can wreak havoc on the rule of law in this country. While every Republican president has had to deal with unfair, biased decisions from the nation's federal judiciary from time to time, only Trump has seen one terrible ruling after another directed at his administration. Many of these rulings cannot be defended by any legal expert, much less anyone who thinks the Constitution should be a court's guiding light. They are manifestly unhinged from any form of U.S. law and any sound legal theory. They are Tumblr-inspired, Resistance-guided rulings that show what a sorry state our courts are really in.

But maybe that's going to soon change. On Tuesday, the White House announced the re-nomination of 51 nominees for vacant federal court positions in an effort to get the wheels of Congress moving once again on one of the most important aspects of the Trump agenda.

From Fox News:

Nine of the 51 appointments are for spots on prestigious and influential federal appellate benches, including two on the most liberal San Francisco-based 9th Circuit Court of Appeals, which President Trump has often derided as "disgraceful" and politically biased.

Neomi Rao, the president's "regulatory czar," who would take seat on the D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals, is on the list.

now-Supreme Court Associate Justice Brett Kavanaugh's vacated Case Western University School of Law professor and Washington Post commentator Jonathan H. Adler wrote when Rao first joined the administration that "Trump's selection of Rao suggests the administration is serious about regulatory reform, not merely reducing high-profile regulatory burdens."

The White House, along with Senate GOP leaders, has made appointing conservative judges and justices a key priority. Under the Trump administration, 85 federal judges have been installed, including Associate Supreme Court Justices Neil Gorsuch and Brett Kavanaugh, and 30 appellate judges.

Mulvaney says Trump didn't lose shutdown battle

The acting chief of staff strived to put the best face on the situation, even as others doubled down on the notion that it was a setback for Trump and his policies. By BRENT D. GRIFFITHS

The oft-repeated saying in politics is that no one wins when the federal government shuts down. On Sunday, acting White House chief of staff Mick Mulvaney did his best to make sure President Donald Trump wasn't branded the loser this time. "Ultimately, he'll be judged by what happens at the end of this process, not by what happened this week," Mulvaney told John Roberts, Fox News' chief White House correspondent, on "Fox News Sunday."

Mulvaney did his best to spin the wide perception, including among some conservatives, that Trump caved Friday by agreeing to reopen the federal government after the longest shutdown in American history without any money for his central campaign promise of a wall along the Mexican border. Instead, he stressed, the White House is ready to charge into three weeks of negotiations and test whether it can break rank-and-file Democrats from party leadership and garner support for the wall.

"I think the president saw a chance to try to take the Democrats at their word," Mulvaney said. "This gave it a chance for the Democrats to prove whether or not they really believe in border security and [are] willing to [go] against Nancy Pelosi or whether they are so beholden to their leadership that they will never vote for a barrier on the southern border."

It is unclear how the next 21 days of negotiations could yield a broad immigration deal with money for a wall that has eluded everyone for the past 35 days, but like Trump, Mulvaney vowed that a wall would be built one way or another. During the shutdown, Trump and Republicans tried repeatedly to peel support from House Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-Calif.) and the Democratic Party leadership through public invitations to the White House, but most of those invites were declined and there was no large exodus elsewhere.


