


**SWEET TASTE OF LIBERTY BAKE SALE** by Gail DeMario

## SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT . . .

There are 30,000 "Gun Related Deaths" per year by Firearms, and this number is not disputed. U.S. population 324,059,091 as of Wednesday, June 22, 2016. Do the math: 0.0000925 of the population dies from Gun Related Actions each year. Statistically speaking, this is insignificant! What is never told, however, is a breakdown of those 30,000 deaths, to put them in perspective as compared to other causes of death:

- 65% of those Deaths are by "Suicide" which would never be prevented by gun laws.
- 15% are by "Law Enforcement" in the line of duty and justified.
- 17% are through "Criminal Activity", gang and drug related or mentally ill persons – gun violence.
- 3% are "Accidental Discharge" deaths.

So technically, "Gun Violence" is not 30,000 annually, but drops to 5,100. Still too many? Well, first, how are those deaths spanned across the nation?

- 480 homicides (9.4%) were in Chicago
- 344 homicides (6.7%) were in Baltimore
- 333 homicides (6.5%) were in Detroit.
- 119 homicides (2.3%) were in Washington D.C. (a 54% increase over prior years)

So basically, 25% of all "Gun Crime" happens in just 4 Cities.. All 4 of those cities have strict gun laws, so it is not the "Lack of Law" that is the Root Cause.

This basically leaves 3,825 for the entire rest of the nation, or about 75 deaths per state. That is an average because some States have much higher rates than others. For example, California had 1,169 and Alabama had only 1.

Now, who has the strictest gun laws by far? "California", of course, but understand, it is not guns causing this. It is a crime rate spawned by the number of criminal persons residing in those cities and states. So if all cities and states are not created equally, then there must be something other than the tool causing the gun deaths.

Are 5,100 deaths per year horrific? How about in comparison to other deaths? All death is sad and especially so when it is in the commission of a crime but that is the nature of crime. Robbery, death, rape, assault all is done by criminals and thinking that criminals will obey laws is ludicrous. That's why they are criminals.

But what about other Deaths each year?

- 40,000+ die from a "Drug Overdose"—THERE IS NO EXCUSE FOR THAT!
- 36,000 people Die per year from "The Flu", far exceeding the Criminal Gun Deaths.
- 34,000 people Die per year in "Traffic Fatalities" (exceeding Gun Deaths even if you include Suicide)

Now it gets good:

- 200,000+ people Die each year (and growing) from preventable "Medical Errors", You are safer in Chicago than when you are in a Hospital !

• 710,000 people Die per year from "Heart Disease".. It's time to stop the Double Cheeseburgers! So what is the point? If the anti-gun movement focused their attention on heart disease, even a 10% decrease in cardiac deaths would save twice the number of lives annually of all gun-related deaths (including suicide, law enforcement, etc..). A 10% reduction in medical errors would be 66% of the total gun deaths or 4 times the number of criminal homicides.....Simple, easily preventable 10% reductions! So you have to ask yourself, in the grand scheme of things, why the focus on Guns? It's pretty simple: Taking away Guns gives control to Governments.

The Founders of this Nation knew that regardless of the form of Government, those in Power may become Corrupt and seek to rule as the British did by trying to Disarming the Populace of the Colonies. It is not difficult to understand that a Disarmed Populace is a Controlled Populace..

Thus, the second amendment was proudly and boldly included in the U.S. Constitution. It must be preserved at all costs.

So the next time someone tries to tell you that "Gun Control" is about "Saving Lives", look at these Facts and remember These Words from Noah Webster: "Before a standing Army can Rule, the people must be Disarmed, as they are in almost every Kingdom in Europe. **California now recognizes "non-binary" gender.** California Gov. Jerry Brown signed a law on Sunday that will allow Californians to identify themselves as having a "nonbinary" gender on state identification documents, rather than having to choose either male or female.

The law, SB 179, was introduced by State Sens. Scott Wiener (YES - that's really his name; D-San Francisco) and Toni Atkins (D-San Diego). It aims to allow transgender people a way to identify themselves on state documents without "the need for a court order or proof of clinical treatment to apply for gender changes," the Sacramento Bee says.

**California convalescent and retirement home workers can go to jail for using the wrong pronoun.** I reported on this monstrosity last issue, but the Governor signed it into law. Bottom line - if gramps thinks he's Eleanor Roosevelt, the workers in the facility in which he resides can be put in jail if they don't refer to him as such. Good to see the Legislature is dealing with the really important stuff - yes?

Okay - I could go on for pages about the bad stuff. None of it would be surprising and most of it would be depressing. And the Governor has another 2 weeks to sign or veto bills, so there will be plenty of detritus to report on next month. So let me relay a bit of good news on the Governor's vetoes.

**The Governor vetoed bill that would have imposed a new data collection mandate on California employers and exposed them to costly litigation.** The California Chamber of Commerce identified AB 1209 (Gonzalez Fletcher; D-San Diego) as a job killer because it would have "created a false impression of wage discrimination or unequal pay where none exists, therefore subjecting employers to unfair public criticism; exposed employers to significant litigation costs to defend against meritless claims." The Governor stated in his veto message he is worried that the ambiguity in AB 1209 "could be exploited to encourage more litigation than pay equity." Other than that it was almost perfect.

**He vetoed AB 569: Outlawing Codes of Conduct related to Abortion and Sexual Behavior.** Authored by Assemblywoman. Gonzalez Fletcher, and supported by usual suspects NARAL Pro-Choice California and California Latinas for Reproductive Justice, this bill specifically outlawed employee codes of conduct that prohibit abortion, contraception, or sex outside of marriage. The bill is specifically targeting faith-based educational institutions, but will affect every faith-based organization - and some non-faith based as well.

**He also vetoed Assembly Bill 63, which would have required Californians of ages 18 to 22 to wait at least 60 days after receiving their driving learner's permits and complete at least 50 hours of supervised driving before applying for licenses.** Then, once receiving provisional licenses, these young drivers could operate cars for the first year only within strict limits, such as no driving between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. and not carrying passengers younger than 20 without supervision.

It was aimed at reducing accidents involving young drivers. But as Brown pointed out in his veto message, it would treat young Californians who are considered adults in almost every other respect - such as being allowed to vote and being eligible for military service - as if they were wayward children. The real wayward children are in the Legislature.

This was one of several bills trying to redefine adulthood that were considered in the legislative session. They included one to drop the voting age to 16 and another to make it more difficult for teenagers to be legally married. Consistency has never been a hallmark of the California Legislature.

And there were some bills that were so bad that even the Democrat super-majority legislature gagged at passing them.

**SB 705 (Allen; D-Santa Monica)** Would have increased cost of prepared food, overly burden the restaurant industry, and threatens loss of jobs by banning food service containers made from expanded polystyrene foam as of January 1, 2020. Let's do what the Brits do and have all take-out food served in old newspaper pages. Yea - that's the ticket!

**AB 1645 (Muratsuchi; D-Torrance)** Would have dramatically increased the cost of gas, on top of the tax increase coming soon to a pump near you, by banning the use of hydrogen fluoride and hydrofluoric acid at refineries that use more than 250 gallons and are located within two miles of a residence, notwithstanding the fact that there are significant safety regulations in place at the local, state and federal levels.

**SB 562 (Lara; D-Bell Gardens)** This was the Bernie Sanders socialized medicine "single payer" scheme. It would have penalized responsible employers and individuals and resulted in significant new taxes on all Californians and California businesses by creating a new single-payer government-run, multibillion-dollar health care system financed by an unspecified and undeveloped "revenue plan." The anticipated cost was \$400 billion - more than twice the annual state budget. This was too much even for ultra-liberal Assembly Speaker Rendon, who categorized SB 562 as "woefully incomplete" and shelved it.

## Trump Says NO to Brown Delta Tunnel Scam—Saves 10’s of Billions \$\$\$



The Trump Administration will not help pay for or support the massive project to drill water tunnels beneath the California Delta, a top Department of the Interior official says Wednesday.

The tunnels are being pushed by Gov. Edmund Gerald Brown Jr. and some customers of the State Water Project, most notably the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California.

But any hope of help from the Trump Administration to pay for the project, with its estimated \$17-\$67 billion price tag, or even support it, seems to have evaporated with a statement Wednesday from Interior Department deputy communications director Russell Newell.

“The Trump administration did not fund the project and chose to not move forward with it,” Mr. Newell said in a statement to the Los Angeles Times.

Mr. Brown had found support for his legacy project from the Obama administration.

One of the project’s long-standing opponents says the rejection by the Trump Administration is “another nail in the coffin for the project.”

“Water exporters have only pulled together about \$6 billion in funding, and even a single ... tunnel would start at \$10-11 billion,” says Executive Director of Restore the Delta Barbara Barrigan-Parrilla. “In addition, it is highly unlikely that federal agencies will now sign off on the Record of Decision required to begin construction for the project.

“It is time for Governor Brown to get serious about solving California’s water problems with 21st century solutions. It is time for him to work with all people across the state to promote and create programs of regional self-sufficiency and to repair existing infrastructure.”

The project, if funding were ever found for it, would still need the go-ahead from the Interior Department. The department is under investigation for what appears to have been unauthorized spending of \$84 million to help pay for planning the project.






