

SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE

"Congressman Trey Gowdy reminded everyone Wednesday that the Speaker of the House does not need to actually be a sitting congressman.

The Constitution dictates "the House of Representatives shall choose their Speaker and other Officers," but it does not stipulate that you have to be a sitting member of Congress to run for the leadership position. Gowdy conveniently pointed that out at the end of his statement on Speaker Paul Ryan's decision not to seek re-election at the end of his term.

After calling Ryan the "smartest kid in the class" and wishing him his wife and their three children "all the best," the South Carolina Republican addressed "those within Congress who always seemed to have a better idea or a smarter strategy, now is your chance to run for Speaker."

THREE CALIFORNIAS BY GARY AMINOFF

Three Californias rather than one?

Silicon Valley venture capitalist Tim Draper has come up with a scheme to split California into three states, and he's collected twice as many signatures as he needs to get the proposition on the ballot in November. Some 600,000 Californians have signed his petition, which would allow a vote on whether to split the state into North California, South California and California. If it gets on the ballot in November, it passes, in my opinion.

Here is what it would look like:

He has done one thing correctly. He has roughly equalized population among the three regions in his proposal. The effect, however, would be to syphon all the conservatives off into one state — South California — and create two progressive states. In other words, progressives would get four U.S. senators and conservatives just two. What about the House of Representatives? Excluding states that only get one representative as well as the District of Columbia, which gets zero, each member of the House represents 705,524.19 people. That makes it easy to calculate House membership under Draper's proposal. North California would get 18 members, South California 19 and (Coastal) California 16. Curiously, the conservative state would get more representatives than either of the other two. But note the total of 34 progressive representatives to 19 conservative representatives. (These figures assume total representation in the House would equal California's current 53 members.) As For Gerrymandering Pay close attention to the map. Note that Orange County and San Diego County are lumped in with

the conservative farming areas of the Inland Empire. While this equalizes the population, it removes a large conservative component from the Coastal California state. In fact, Orange County and several of its cities have sued the state to be allowed to opt out of the "sanctuary state" status that has been declared by Sacramento.

Whether intentional or not, this would slightly change the balance in the Electoral College. Each state's representation is equal to the sum of its senators and representatives in the House. California's current Electoral College representation is 55. The proposed new state would add four new senators, bringing the total to 59. While this usually would not cause a change in the overall vote, it could conceivably make a difference.

Draper argues CAL 3 would solve many of California's most pressing issues, including the state's failing school systems, highest-in-the-nation taxes, deteriorating infrastructure and strained government, by allowing regional communities to make decisions for their citizens.

Some feel the State of California is too large anyway, and that the 6 Million or so conservatives in the State need to have their own political voice. I agree.

Californians will have a chance to divide the State this November.

No Sanctuary for Criminals in These Counties

Bill's Bills

Ah yes – Spring has sprung and so have the socialists in Sacramento, aiming at your pocketbook and general common sense. But to start you off this issue with a smile, take a look at a couple of worthwhile bills:

Good News !

AB 1743 (O'Donnell; D-Long Beach) Career Technical Education — Reauthorizes and provides appropriations for the Career Technical Education Incentive Grant program, which provides students with necessary training and vocational education to prepare them for a variety of career options.

AB 2482 (Voepel; R-Santee) Flexible Workweek — Allows for an employee-selected flexible work schedule and relieves employers of the administrative cost and burden of adopting an alternative workweek schedule per division, which accommodates employees, helps retain employees, and allows the employer to invest these savings into growing its workforce.

AB 2907 (Flora; R-Ripon) Private Attorneys General Act — Provides employers with a reasonable opportunity to cure specific Labor Code violations before being subject to costly and frivolous litigation under the Labor Code Private Attorneys General Act (PAGA), allowing an employer to invest this financial savings into growing its workforce. Before you get too excited however, here's just a soupcon of the things floating around the cesspool known as our legislature.

Also in the good news department is the growing wave of resistance to the insane "sanctuary" policy that Governor Moonbeam and our Sacramento socialists have forced on our citizens. More and more local governments are fighting back, opposing sanctuary laws and joining the Federal suit against California's clearly unconstitutional view that we can pick and choose which laws to obey. The honor roll so far includes: Orange County, San Diego County, Los Alamitos, Anderson, Huntington Beach, Newport Beach, Escondido, Yorba Linda, Barstow, Orange, Fountain Valley, Hesperia, Westminster, Mission Viejo, San Juan Capistrano, Aliso Viejo, Beaumont and Dana Point. At least another dozen local governments are considering joining this brave band.

And of course what would a Bill's Bills be without a global cooling...err global warming...err climate change update. This from the AP: "Records fell as an April snowstorm blanketed the Upper Midwest. The National Weather Service says the 14.9 inches at Minneapolis airport from Friday through Sunday set a record for the largest April snowstorm ever there. It's also the snowiest April on record in the Twin Cities. And it's the snowiest start to a calendar year there, with 70.3 inches since Jan. 1.

Neil Gorsuch Supreme Court Justice

Neil Gorsuch has only been on the Supreme Court for a short while. Recently he ignited the fire of liberty and broke 40 years of precedent when he refused to join the SCOTUS "cert pool."

The cert pool was established in 1973 during the early days of the Burger Court, in order to efficiently review the near 8,000 petitions received each term.

In practice, the petitions are apportioned among the Court's law clerks, who then circulate a memo to the justices recommending a grant or denial.

The obvious problem here is that this gives the power in these 8,000 cases to the law clerks instead of the Justices. It also, in theory, allows 3rd parties to unfairly influence a case through the clerks.

That is NOT how the Supreme Court was designed to operate. Neil Gorsuch just managed to set his foot down in the Supreme Court and say it is NOT okay to pass off judgments to the discretion of law clerks. This is the kind of story everyone should be hearing or reading in the media, but obviously is not.

The United States Supreme Court recently issued a direct and final blow to the Islamic Indoctrination of the young in this nation. The full panel of the United States Supreme Court which consists of 9 judges met to decide the fate of Islamic indoctrination in our American public schools.

In a typical 5 to 4 decision, common sense won out, and we have sanity restored to our schools once again.

The United States Supreme Court was able to hand out this decision banning Sharia Law and Islam from being taught in classrooms because of the tie-breaking vote of the newly appointed Supreme Court Justice Neil Gorsuch.

Gorsuch went on to write about the decision: The government certainly has no business being involved in religion, but this isn't a government issue or a religious issue. This is about the judicial branch interpreting the laws as they apply to the teaching of religion. We shouldn't be teaching any religions in the public schools of this country.




